

System - Ubuntu/Gnome 14.04
Wine Version - 1.8
Winetricks Version – 20161228

Install Wine 1.8 Stable from Ubuntu Wine Team PPA:
(If you already have Wine installed goto #4)

Paste below commands in Terminal and run one by one:

1. Add the PPA via command:

sudo add-apt-repository ppa:ubuntu-wine/ppa

Type in your password when it asks, and hit Enter to continue.

2. Update package cache and install wine1.8:

sudo apt-get update

sudo apt-get install wine1.8 winetricks

3. Create default .wine prefix

winecfg

4. Create 32 bit prefix

WINEARCH=win32 WINEPREFIX=~/.wine-Pimx winecfg

5. Run Winetricks in the new prefix

WINEPREFIX=~/.wine-Pimx winetricks

In Winetricks:

- Select the default wineprefix
- Install a Windows DLL or component
 - **python26 Python interpreter 2.6.2**
- Install a font
 - **corefonts MSArial, Courier, Times fonts**

6. Install SC4-PIM X in new prefix

WINEPREFIX=~/.wine-Pimx wine ~/ [path to file] /SetupSC4PIMRC8c.exe

7. Run SC4-PIM X in new prefix

WINEPREFIX=~/.wine-Pimx wine SC4PIM.exe

*****caveat:** If you do not have SC4 installed, when you run SC4-PIM X, you must uncheck all the boxes in the first window that comes up, or if you do have SC4 installed you must uncheck the boxes that have a blank path entry or you will get the following errors:
